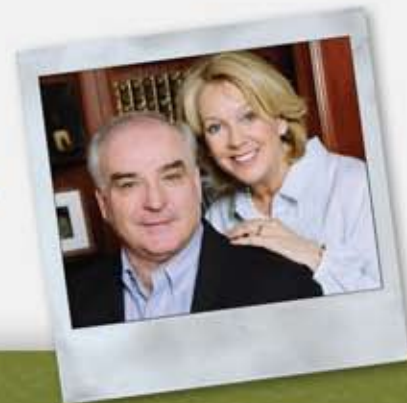

Key Text: Exodus 4:1-5

Key Text: John 13:5

Today's cultural beatitudes sound like this: "blessed are the takers" or "blessed are the self-promoters." However, Jesus could do anything, yet He served. How radical is that? Typically their hearts of service and gracious ways stand out like a beacon. God is calling the Christ Fellowship family not

Day 5

Extravagant Choice

Key Text: Philippians 1

What choices are worth dying for? Have you considered that every day we spend a part of our lives that we never get back? We literally are "dying" for something all the time! That means that every decision, choice, and selection are significant. In other words, there are no casual days and no common moments. God is presenting the opportunity to make significant,

far-reaching, even extravagant choices. These investments result in transferring the Good News to others. It's "worth dying for."

Pray that God will move on each of us to be extravagant with our love for Him!

"Above all, you must live as citizens of heaven, conducting yourselves in a manner worthy of the Good News about Christ."

Day 6

Hilarious (Cheerful) Generosity

Key Text: 2 Corinthians 9:1-15

Wired into our very souls is a joy that is unleashed in only one way. A hole in one, shopping, a surprise bonus at work all sound great, but these do not release this joy. This sense of joy happens when we are generous. Generosity is seen in simple acts of kindness all the way to magnanimous acts of great personal sacrifice. Many have been so inspired by single acts

of generosity that they make it their life! Why does generosity result in joy? Because it reflects the nature of God, the greatest giver of all.

Pray that God will unleash this joy in ways you have never known.

"For God is the one who provides seed for the farmer and then bread to eat. In the same way, He will provide and increase your resources and then produce a great harvest of generosity in you."

2 CORINTHIANS 9:10 (NLT)

Pray that God would make obvious how He would have you respond to the One Life opportunity.
