



Christ Fellowship GK Praise Team Guidelines*

1. Kids auditioning for this leadership team must be in 3rd - 5th grades. Middle/High School students may also audition to serve in a team leadership position. All applicants must currently participate in a regular weekend worship service and commit to a consistent, age-appropriate Life Group at Christ Fellowship.
2. All applicants will audition on scheduled date and with the required materials. The audition does not guarantee placement on the team. The purpose of the audition is to help discern if the applicant is gifted in this leadership area of ministry. Those applicants who display an aptitude for this giftedness, but who are not quite ready to lead on stage, will be provided the opportunity to grow by participating in rehearsals, and will, at the directors discernment, be considered to join the praise team when they reach the necessary level of skill. They must, however, attend all scheduled rehearsals and show a commitment to growth. Additionally, all previous Praise Team members are not guaranteed a spot on the team and must go through our audition process as well.
3. Once selected, GK Praise Team members will be assigned to a team which will serve one weekend a month and must be available for all services on that weekend. Praise Team members will also need to be available for other special events which will be announced, (i.e., holiday events, family experience events, summer events, etc.).
4. There will be a mandatory monthly all-team rehearsal, which most usually will be held on the last Wednesday evening of the month. Each team will also have a Saturday night "Team" rehearsal on the weekend for which they are scheduled to serve. Additional rehearsals will be required for special events (TBA).
5. GK Praise Team members are making a one year service commitment.
6. GK Praise Team members are required to learn music that is presented to them in a timely fashion and will come to Saturday night rehearsals familiar with their materials and ready to rehearse.
7. Parents, not kids, are required to call ahead of time and inform the director of any conflicts in schedule or absences.
8. GK Praise Team members are required to wear their Praise Team T-shirt and jeans and closed shoes (no open toe shoes) on their service weekend.*
9. It is the commitment of GK Praise Team adult leaders to help team members learn how to use their gifts and talents to lead others in the praise and worship of God and to model true servant leadership.
