IN A NUTSHELL

In Revelation 4:7 the four faces of God are mentioned. This week we are digging deeper into Pastor's message on the third face – the face of man. Man was created in God's image and we represent God's love. Going from this final book of the Bible all the way back to the first, there is reference to humanity's origins. We were given dominion over God's creatures and the environment. God loved us so much that He sent His Son to live among us and sacrifice Himself for our sin. Christ rose from the dead, experiencing victory over death, and sits at the throne of the Father to intercede for us. Jesus is alive. He is alive in us and through our redemption we receive the love and grace of God and eternal life.

TALK IT OUT

1. We are living in a fallen world, a country pulling away from its Christian foundations, yet we are friends of God and God loves us. How can we keep encouraged, and help each other to recognize God's plan for us? What are we created to do with our lives?
2. God created us with love and redeemed us back to Himself with mercy and grace through Jesus Christ, His Son. When we are born again, we become ambassadors of Jesus Christ. How can we have godly relationships that reflect God's presence in us? Is there a co-worker, friend, or family member to whom you need to show forgiveness and reflect God's love? What steps can you take to make this happen?
3. We all want to receive God's love in revelation. How can we prepare ourselves to receive our heavenly home and experience intimacy with God?

DRAW IT OUT

We were created in God's image to rule here on earth. We were given companionship and need to develop God honoring relationships that reflect God's presence in us. When we surrender to God's will we allow ourselves to let God be our daily Provider. God has kept His covenant relationship with us and we must strive to be obedient and be in covenant with Him. Live out a life that shows honor and respect to God so that you are prepared to receive your eternal blessing.
